

Creating an Account

The first time you visit the RPR website (<http://www.narrpr.com>), you will need your NRDS ID. When you arrive at the homepage, select the link that reads “Create New Account”.

Have your NRDS ID and MLS ID handy, you’ll need that during the sign up process. Signing up is broken up into a 5-step sign up wizard.
